2. The Word of God as speech
3. The Word of God as speech through human lips
1 Corinthians 2:13, 2 Corinthians 13:3
4. The Word of God as the written Scripture

Value of our words

- Whenever you speak
 - 1 Peter 4:11 “Do you have the gift of speaking? Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. Then everything you do will bring glory to God through Jesus Christ. All glory and power to him forever and ever! Amen.”

What should we do?

- Read the Word
 - Psalm 119:11 “I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.”
- Pray the Word
 - Psalm 119:105 “Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path.”
- Speak the Word
 - Psalm 19:14 “May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing to you, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.”
- Practice the Word
 - Luke 11:28 – Jesus replied, “But even more blessed are all who hear the word of God and put it into practice.”

How can they hear ...?

“But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?¹⁵ And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!” Romans 10:14-15
